2023 Quadrennial Conference DECORUM COMMITTEE REPORT

POINTS OF REFERENCE

- 1. That all business be conducted with Christian love towards one another.
- 2. The normal rules of order are observed as directed by the Chairman.
- 3. The bar of the conference business session shall be in the front 6 rows.
- The IPHC 2022-2026 Manual clearly states (p 127, Sec. B) only those who are in compliance, passed at the last quadrennial conference, can vote or serve in official positions.
- According to procedures adopted by the Conference Executive Board in March 2010 and implemented prior to quadrennial conference, and subsequent conferences, nominations for the RMC Executive Council will be accepted by mail, either standard or electronic, by the first day of the new fiscal year.
- 6. The Executive Council will review all nominations and certify those nominated are eligible to serve.
- 7. Nominations on the floor will not be accepted.
- 8. Absentee and proxy ballots are not permitted.
- 9. Each delegate may only vote on one name per ballot.
- 10. There will be an election when one nominee receives at least 51% of the votes cast.
- 11. When there are five (5) or more nominations, the two (2) nominees with the least number of votes will be dropped after the first ballot, if elections are not complete. If the election is still not complete, the Chairman will determine the number of names to be dropped in succeeding ballots.
